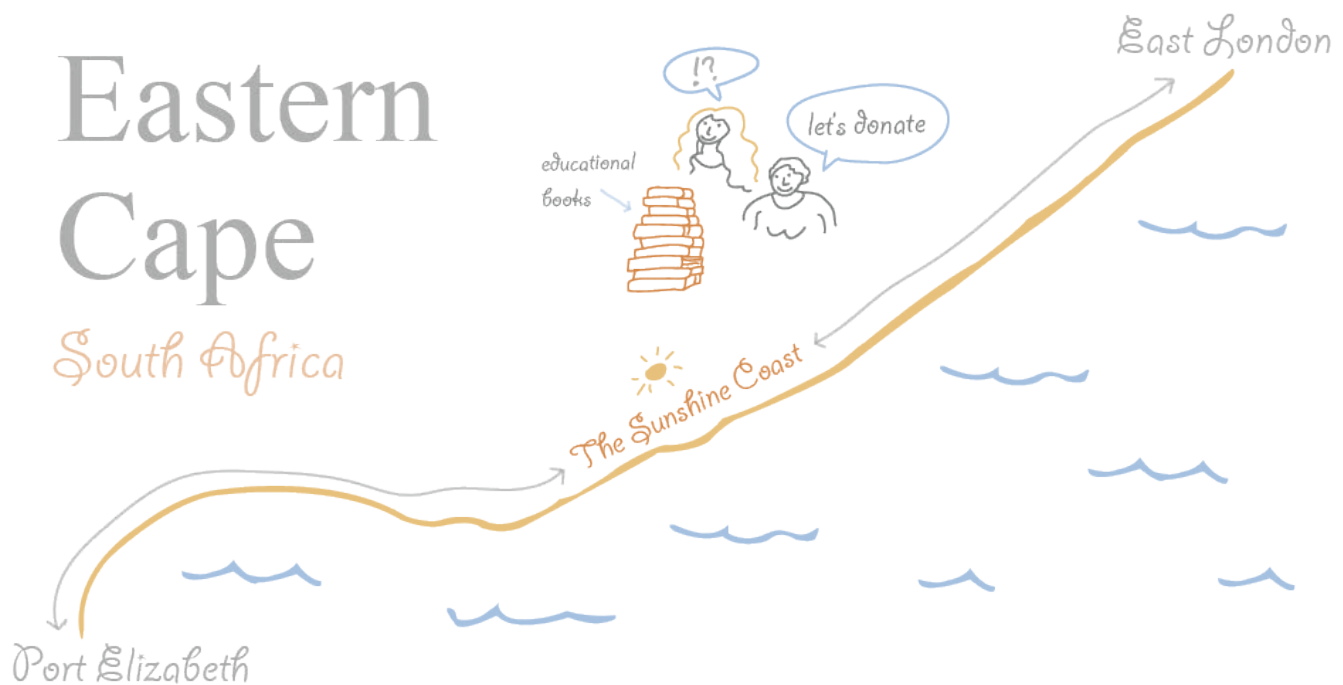




It's time to give back...

The journey began when Susan Dovey and Angela Kaplan, the founders, voluntarily donated books to one of the local schools on the Sunshine Coast and after a tour of the school it was evident that there were very few essential amenities available which therefore made learning and teaching a very difficult and challenging task.



Our aim is to contribute to the local community. The focus of our efforts is on the uplifting of the youth, caring for the environment and assisting in local conservation and also supporting the SAPS, municipalities and various other organizations.

Our aims, objectives and focus of our charity include the following:

Supporting the local community on the Sunshine Coast and upliftment of the youth. This is done irrespective of sex, ethnicity, religion, health or political view. Local schools (pre-primary, primary and high schools), crèches, soup kitchens, orphanages, safe houses, disabled centers, and local sporting teams are included.

Caring for the environment and assisting in local conservation.

Providing medical supplies for the various beaches.

Supporting the local Sunshine Coast branch of the South African Police.

Supporting the Sunshine Coast Municipality.

Joint ventures with the following highly acclaimed and trusted organisations, Rotary Kenton on Sea and Child Welfare South Africa Kenton/Bushman's and the Sunshine Coast Charity Trust.

Our disbursements over the past nine years have included the following:

Supporting various crèches, pre-primary schools, primary schools and senior schools in the area by supplying or helping with, playground equipment, photocopiers, buildings, sports equipment, sports fields, cricket nets, gardens, vegetable gardens, libraries or water tanks.

Institutions that have been helped include: Kenton Primary School, Ekamvalesizwe Municipal Library, Ekamvalesizwe School, Alex Primary School, Bhongweni Primary School Alex, Siyabulela Day Care Alex, Marseille Combined School, Masibambisane Pre School Port Alfred and Klipfontein crèches and school.

Child Welfare Sunshine Coast – to assist, feed and educate children in the community.

Bam Orphanage in Alexandria was provided with meal vouchers.

Thokomala Foster Home received equipment.

Young Chiefs Football Club / Alex Football Club All Stars were helped with transport, clothing and soccer boots. Kenton Sports Trust was assisted with various school projects.

SAMREC (SA Marine Rehabilitation and Education Centre) received help to purchase penguin coops and aid for rehabilitation.

SAPS Sunshine Coast were provided with Christmas hampers, computers, stationery, furnishings for the child 'victim support' room and rape kits.

Kenton / Bushman's Conservation received beach first aid kits, equipment and educational marine life billboards.

We have teamed up with the local Kenton on Sea Rotary Club and are working together on various outdoor education camps like 'Hobbitin On Fairewood', feeding schemes and orphanages.

Sunshine Coast Charity Trust received support for education, supplies and soup kitchens.

Support was provided for the Pumelela Youth Development Organisation – Port Alfred.

Keiskamma Music Academy received support.

JOT, a reading club, received books.
